Short biography

Hannah Borthwick was born and grew up in Johannesburg, South Africa. After completing high school, she enrolled for the BDram course at the University of Stellenbosch. A highlight of her student years, was her role as Sally Bowles in Marthinus Basson's stage production of *Cabaret*. As her role included acting, singing and dancing it was her biggest challenge thus far. She subsequently won the Stellenbosch Drama Department's Best Actress award and was nominated for the *Fleur du Cap* student award in 2009. She was nominated again in 2010 and won. Her first professional production

was also under the direction of Marthinus Basson in Willem Anker's *Sakrament* which premiered at KKNK 2009.
